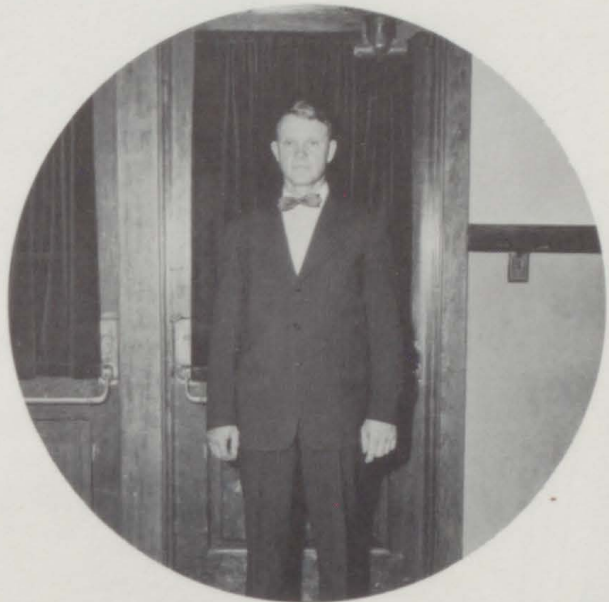
IN MEMORIAM



Ronnie Ratliff, son of Mr. and Mrs. Henry Ratliff, passed suddenly from our midst July 18, 1954.

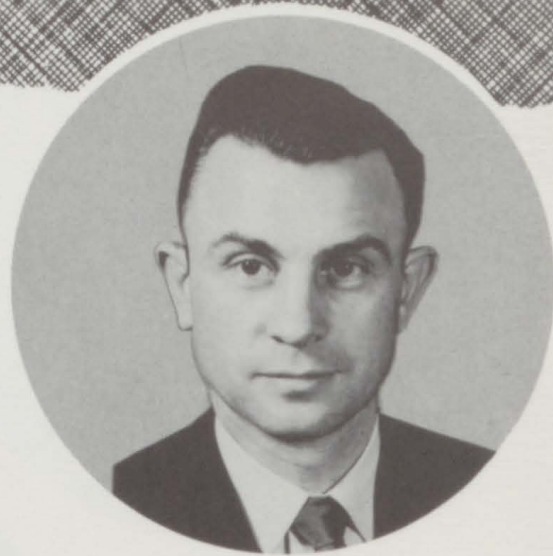

\$291,940

The Bland Co. School Board has accepted a low bid of \$291,940 as submitted by Trinkle & Dobyns Construction of Dublin, Va. for the joint construction of the new Rocky Gap High School and Bastian Elementary.

The Rocky Gap building, consisting of science laboratory, commercial room, cafeteria, library, gymnasium, five general classrooms, administrative, waiting room, girls' and boys' restrooms, comprising a total cost of \$21,611. The building will be financed by \$96,448 in state Battle Construction money supplemented by \$120,000 provided by Rocky Gap Magisterial District of Bland Co.

The Bastian Elementary School, having a total area of 8,580 sq. ft., will cost \$93,662. It will be financed by \$75,000 in State Battle Construction money with the balance being provided by Seddon Magisterial District. The contract price is also exclusive of equipment. Both buildings are to be brick structure.
