When Rocky Gap Basketball fans reminisce and bestow accolades on the cage stars of the past, they may recall many fine players. In the late 50 's, there was a kid they called "Cousy" who handled the ball like his protege and would often play music on the cotton strings from $30^{\prime}$ plus. The adjectives, dedicated, talented, and awesome, adequately describe the athletic prowess of our own superstar, Pat Sutphin. He is a stupendous individual both on and off the basketball court.
