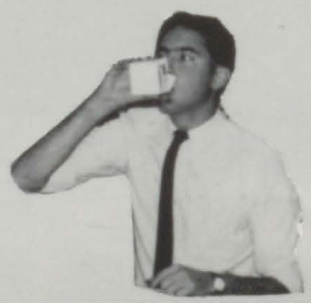


# Why Be Normal When You Can Be . . .

The different personalities and individuality of the senior class keeps us apart from the regular crowd.







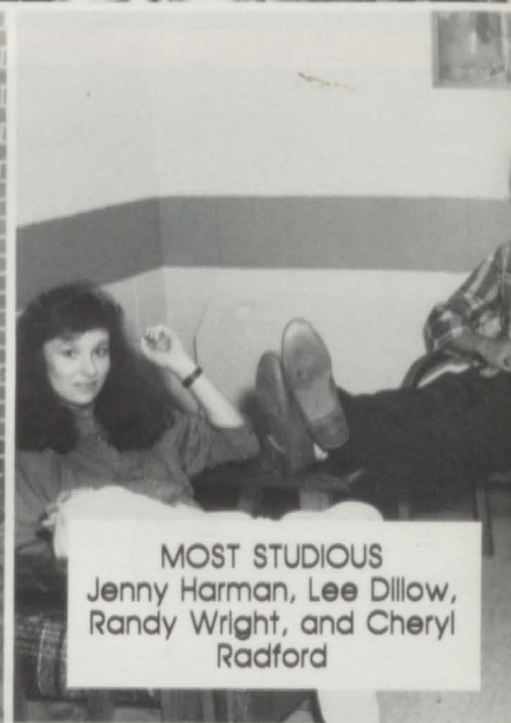
